Where each bud blooms in its true colours,

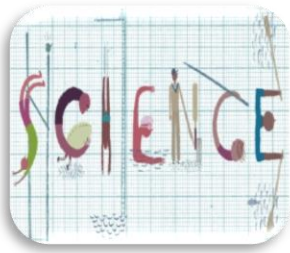

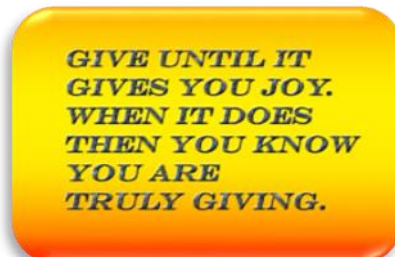
