Thus, the “Annual Sports Meet – 2016” was organised on 27th and 28th October with a lot of pomp and vigor, with many athletic events, scintillating performances, demonstrations of yoga, taekwondo and mallakamba to name a few, for the students of Class I to XII to showcase their sports talent.





The inaugural event of the Sports meet was displayed by the “Jazzy Stutters” of Class I who marched around the ground with whole lot of enthusiasm and overwhelming energy, waving to the audience.
